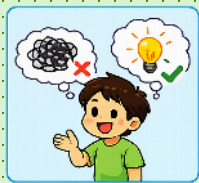
### Seirinkan High School Open School

## **EIKEN Speaking Interview Tips**



### **Use simple and clear English**

You do not need difficult vocabulary. Correct and natural simple English is better than complicated sentences with mistakes.



### **Stay calm and keep eye contact**

Confidence matters. If you make a mistake, continue speaking instead of stopping or apologizing too much. Interviewers care about communication and effort.



### **Watch your pronunciation and intonation**

Speak clearly, stress important words, and avoid speaking too fast. Natural pauses can make your speech easier to understand.



### **Answer immediately**

Do not stay silent for too long. Even if you are unsure, start speaking. The interview checks communication ability, not perfect English.



### **Give longer answers**

Avoid one-word answers like "Yes" or "No." Add a reason or detail.
