▶ Mactan Cebu International Airport welcomed the arrival of a group of students from Nagoya, Japan last June 4. This is the first big group of students coming back to Cebu for English as a Second Language (ESL) face-to-face classes since the pandemic.

Through the initiative of the Department of Tourism in Central Visayas and DOT Osaka, in collaboration with the ESL school associations, ESL physical classes from Japan are gradually resuming.

For more than ten years Cebu has attracted ESL students from South Korea and Japan. Some few years later Taiwanese and Chinese students started to come too. The presence of direct flights from Cebu to these countries is a major factor for the growth of ESL in Cebu coupled with good facilities like schools and competent teachers. ESL in Cebu is not only affordable in comparison to its rival countries. Cebu is also a top tourist destination that is popular not only with students. Cebu is also a top choice for their families who get to island's experience the famous and mouth-watering food, white sandy beaches, world renowned diving sites and other tourist attractions.



▶ GMCAC consolidated all departures in Terminal 2 (T2) effective January 16 to give way to repair works in Terminal 1 (T1) which suffered far greater damage from the onslaught of typhoon "Odette" (international code name: Rai) last December.

The resumption of domestic flights and the recent increase in international traffic due to the opening of borders necessitate the relocation of some domestic traffic to T1. However, the relocation will be gradual and limited as repair and renovation works are still ongoing in certain areas of T1.




Meanwhile, all domestic arrivals will continue to arrive at T1. Passengers were amply advised via social media and support staff at the terminals are available to ensure they are given appropriate guidance on the changes.

Domestic departures of Philippine Airlines and Air Asia will continue to operate from T2 until further notice.

Travelers taking international flights can access the lounge by taking the lift across Gate No. 20 on Departure Level to Level 1.

GMCAC ATTENDS ROUTES ASIA 2022

Around 500 delegates from Asia Pacific and some from Europe, the Middle East and North America gathered last June 6-8 in Da Nang Vietnam at Routes Asia 2022. A constant attendee of this event, GMCAC met 13 airlines, five airports, three aviation suppliers and an on-line travel agent.
This is the first Routes Asia face-to-face conference since the pandemic and airlines, airports, tourism authorities and aviation stakeholders eagerly discussed, shared best practices and worked together to develop air services across Asia Pacific.

TAIWAN LIFTS TRANSIT BAN

The directive order of Taiwan Center for Disease Control (CDC) imposing transit ban in Taiwan has been lifted effective June 15. All flights with transit in Taipei are now allowed.
Passengers arriving and transiting Taiwan are required to present a negative PCR test result taken two (2) days before departure and transferring between airlines is also allowed. Transit time should not exceed 12 hours and must be within the same day.

KOREA TOURISM ORGANIZATION EASES TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS

▶ Korea Tourism Organization announced on June 15 that the Government is removing the mandatory COVID-19 vaccination requirement for travel. Travelers no longer need to prove their vaccination status, however, there is a newly implemented Q-code system, mandatory pre-departure rapid antigen/PCR test and on-arrival PCR test. Travelers who test positive for Covid-19 while in Korea can now isolate in their hotels, at the hotel's approval, instead of a government designated quarantine hotel.


